

Uniform Template Left Shoulder

Fold this template in HALF and align with your uniform as indicated.

The basic rule of Scout uniforming is NEATNESS. Some of the various badges and insignia shown will not apply to you; use this template as a FULLSIZED GUIDE as to how to place/sew insignia onto the official BSA shirts.

Align the top edge of the sheet with the top edge of the shoulder seam. The basic rule is that everything touches each other. All members of UNITS certified with 25 or more years tenure wear the Veteran Bar. Lone Scouts wear the Lone Scout badge instead of unit numbers. Some Councils run "Brownsea" or other Junior Leader Training. Adults wear their position emblem where the Patrol Leader emblem is shown above. Youth and Adults completing the basic training sequence for their PRESENT POSITION may wear the "Trained" strip. Those individuals retired from a position may wear the "Retired" strip instead of the "Trained" strip shown above.
