

Uniform Template Right Side/Pocket

Fold this template in HALF and align with your uniform as indicated.

The basic rule of Scout uniforming is NEATNESS. Some of the various badges and insignia shown will not apply to you; use this template as a FULLSIZED GUIDE as to how to place/sew insignia onto the official BSA shirts.

Only ONE Jamboree (World, international, National) emblem is worn at a time, to include segments if earned, by those individuals serving on staff or as participants (NOT VISITORS) to that Jamboree or encampment. The color of the Interpreter strip does not matter; no more than three should be worn. Some Councils permit the wearing of a "Honor Camper" emblem instead of the OA flap...the placement is the same. Any emblem may be worn centered on the pocket as shown. ONE recruiter strip may be worn below the pocket as shown.
